

Susquehanna Beekeepers Association 2025 Young Beekeeper Grant Worksheet

Purpose: To promote local beekeeping by providing young persons, in partnership with the SBA, basic beekeeping knowledge, skills and equipment. Grant equipment will consist of the following:

- One bottom board, one inner cover, one telescoping outer cover.
- Three medium hive bodies with frames and foundation.
- Bees may be available at cost through the SBA.

Target Age: Persons age 14 to 18 residing in the Harford or Cecil County area.

Requirements:

1. Applicants, if accepted as a recipient, must enroll and complete the “Beekeeping” Short Course through Harford Community College or a similar course. \$60 HCC fee. The 2025 Short Course runs on Friday evenings, February through March. Exact dates and online enrollment forms are available through HCC’s noncredit division.
2. Recipients must accept working with an adult mentor from the SBA (to be assigned).
3. Since this Grant becomes a partnership between the SBA and the family, the recipient will purchase additional equipment as outlined below.
4. The recipient will maintain membership with SBA for at least 2 years and attend (in person or via ZOOM) no less than 6 general meetings per year. Meetings are held monthly.
5. As part of the application process, finalists are subject to an interview by the SBA Board before the grant is awarded (Interviews will take place in early February).
6. A parental consent and a release form will be verified before the grant is awarded.
7. Painting and assembly of beekeeping equipment is required (part of mentorship).
8. The new apiary must be registered and comply with all state and local laws.
9. The apiary must be located in the Harford or Cecil County area.
10. The apiary will be available for inspection by members of the SBA Board of Directors with prior notice.
11. The recipient will present a progress report to the general membership at least once each year during the first 2 years.
12. If the recipient of the grant loses interest in beekeeping during the first 2 years, he or she will return the used equipment to the association or compensate the SBA for the equipment.

****It is strongly recommended that Young beekeeper Grant recipients keep a beekeeping journal and volunteer during SBA events (summer and fall fairs).**

Cost:

The equipment provided in this grant is a start. Additional purchases are required at the beekeeper’s expense. These supplies may include: bees, a protective veil, smoker, gloves, hive tool. Additional hive bodies, frames and foundations are necessary the 2nd year. Prices for the listed beekeeping supplies can be obtained via online searches should be reviewed before submitting this application.
